CMS Proposed Billing Change for Cognitively Impaired Medicare Patients

CMS has proposed a new billing G code (temporary code GPPP6) for the evaluation and treatment planning services for Medicare patients with a cognitive impairment (i.e., dementia), which would take effect January 1, 2016. This proposed code will reimburse providers who meet a stated set of criteria (i.e., medical decision making of moderate/high complexity), which would ultimately exclude psychologists' ability to bill under this code. The APA Practice Organization (APAPO) and Inter Organizational Practice Committee (IOPC) sent official comment letters (APAPO Letter; IOPC Letter) to Administrator Slavitt at CMS in response to these concerns.
